Meeting of the Connect to the Future Working Group

All recommendations will be considered through the lens of the following goals:

ACCESS: Provide access to jobs and services (including for transit reliant and low-income residents).

Access means connecting residents to jobs and their everyday needs via a convenient and reliable system.

CHOICE RIDERSHIP: Attract choice riders.

AFFORDABILITY: Keep the system affordable.

SAFETY: Provide safe access to transit stops.

Ways to provide safe access might include ensuring safe and direct walking routes to and from businesses or redesigning roads to support all users.
